Dear William,

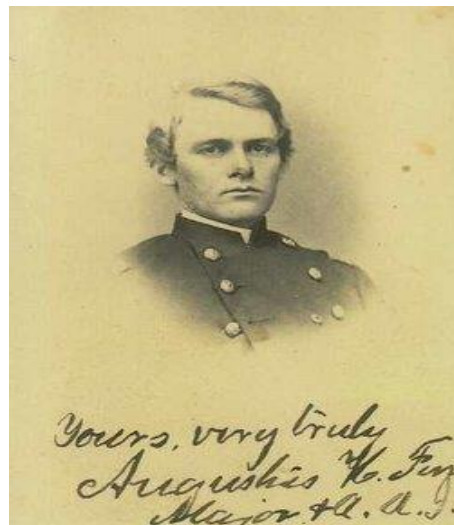
Thanks you for the posting.  
I recall there were two officers in the 2d Connecticut,

Augustus H. Fenn.  
Was a captain from Company C. Promoted to Major on Jan 20, 1865.  
Later on is Lt. Col. by bvt. April 6, 1865 and muster out Aug 18, 1865.  
Residence was Plymouth; CT. Enlistment was July 16, 1862

Joseph B. Fenn.  
First Sgt. Company D. was later promoted to First Lt. Company D. Dec. 20, 1864.  
Muster out Aug. 18, 1865  
Residence was Plymouth; CT. Enlistment was July 26, 1862
